Hayti Heritage Center is bringing back two full days of swing, rhythm and blues at the **27th Annual Bull Durham Blues Festival**. The festival kicks off Friday, Sept. 5, at the **Hayti Performance Hall** and moves to **Durham Athletic Park** on Saturday, Sept. 6.

The Friday night line-up features **The Campbell Brothers'** steel gospel music sound. To celebrate the 50th anniversary of North Carolina native **John Coltrane's** seminal recording of his signature album, the band will perform pieces from *A Love Supreme*. Other icons performing Friday include North Carolina blues icon **John Dee Holeman**, Megafaun's **Phil Cook** and festival newcomers **The Rousters**. Friday's event is presented in collaboration with **Duke Performances**.

The festival returns to its longtime venue at the Durham Athletic Park with the sultry New Orleans sound of **Kermit Ruffins and the Barbecue Swingers**, frequently featured on the HBO series *Treme*. Two-time Grammy nominee **Shemekia Copeland**, Mississippi bluesman **Grady Champion**, Israeli blues performers **The Ori Naftaly Band**, the **Calvin Edwards Trio** and the 2013 Triangle Blues Challenge winners, **The Red Dirt Revelators**, round out the weekend.

Doors open both days at 5pm and the shows start at 6pm. Friday tickets are \$35 in advance and \$40 at the door. Saturday tickets are \$45 in advance and \$50 at the gate. Get your tickets now **online**, by calling 919-683-1709 or in person at the Hayti Heritage Center Box Office.
