2. **Elaine's On Franklin** with **Peregrine Farm**: *Blueberry ginger lemonade and everything veggie lettuce wrap with tomato salsa*

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3. **Foster's Market** with **Open Door Farm**: *Beet, carrot and zephyr squash sliders with spicy micro greens on a purple Viking potato bun.*

4. **Lantern** with **Breeze Incubator Farms**: *Braised Breeze farm vegetables with Chapel Hill Creamery curds and whey*

5. **Il Palio** with **Woodfruit**: *Grilled mushroom crostino with Stracchino cheese*

6. **Glasshalfful** with **Prodigal Farm**: *Slow-roasted goat tacos with mint himichurri and radish slaw served with sangria*

7. **One Restaurant** with **Cane Creek Farm**: *Yellow tomato [Bacon in Eggs] cucumber*

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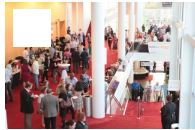
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
